Hal – we need to do some one on one reaching out, we have business cards now, have talking points, need to get a good selling program

Danny suggestion - planned giving – this has a lot of potential, look at in our investments we could use this as a great way to get some more large funds

Friends of the foundation:

Jack Busenbark – lets grow friends of the foundation concept

This one pager will be taken to the Dec 3 meeting so that the presenters, Bobbie Beth and possibly Jack will have something to hand out. This is for the senior citizens group where there are TSD alumni attending.

Chris Soukup and Jack Busenbark, the community awareness and strategic alliances task forces seem to have a potential overlap. Hal agrees to have a conversation with both the task forces to work on spreading the awareness in the best way.
